The US Army Counterinsurgency Center is pleased to host Dr. John A. Bonin, Professor of Concepts and Doctrine at the U.S. Army War College, Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania. Previously, he was the Scholar in Residence for the Army Heritage Center Foundation. He will be presenting and answering questions from the U.S. Army War College on Thursday, 17 March 2011 at 1000 CST, 1100 EST, 1500 ZULU.

His briefing and discussion will focus on Army requirement to prepare and generate general purpose ground forces to meet anticipated growth in small-scale SFA demand and how the institutional Army will provide trainer/advisor certifications, language, culture and regional expertise they need to be successful.
